Librarian Assistants Report: Beth is still researching the new Harry Potter book as well as other Harry Potter books that we don't have available. She will order the new one at this time. Eileen will check on the balance of the book funds. People have requested more books of the Outlander series and also books by author Philippa Gregory. New books that have arrived are; "A Man Called Ove", by Fredrik Backman, "The Dark Root" by Joe Gunther, and "Me Before You", by Jojo Moyes. Beth will add new book titles and authors on our facebook page as they are received. Beth reported that we have more patrons visiting the library.

New Business: We will have a book raffle at the library on September 24th to coincide with the Concord Historical Society Open House at the Town Hall. The adult book to be raffled off will be, "Logging Along the Moose River" by Bill Gore and the children's book will be "The Wild Horses of Sweetbriar" by Natalie Kinsey Warnock. The library hours will be extended one hour on the 24th, so will be open 9-12, and refreshments will be provided.
