**Request #1: Pinheiro, Cynthia, Parcel # 00047**


There were no conflicts with the case to be heard. No one appeared on behalf of C. Pinheiro. Her abatement request form stated financial hardship. A monthly itemized income and expense statement did not accompany the request. At 5:32 p.m. B. Humphrey made the motion to go into Deliberative Session, A. Hovey seconded the motion. Motion passed 9-0. At 5:40 p.m. G. Morehouse made the motion to come out of Deliberative Session, with V. Bergeron seconding the motion. Motion passed 9-0. B. Humphrey made the motion to deny. A. Hovey seconded. Motion passed 9-0. Two other cases where financial hardship was the reason for an abatement request were discussed and referenced. The Duquette case in July of 2012 and the Comeau case in February 2014. Both cases were denied. The board believes precedent has been set. A. Hovey made the motion to deny, S. Gray seconded. Motion passed 9-0.

Having no further business to come before the board, the board adjourned at 5:45 p.m. on a motion by A. Hovey, seconded by C. Gaboriault.


