Minutes of the Library Trustees Meeting

June 5, 2018

Meeting was called to order at 4:09 pm by Eileen Wilson. Mary made the motion to approve the agenda, Paula seconded. The agenda was approved. Paula made the motion to approve the minutes of May 1st meeting, Mary seconded. The minutes were approved.

- 3) Book Signing: A local author, Marilyn Cooper, from Bethlehem NH will have her new book, "Catnip Jazz" on sale at the signing at the Littleton Bookstore on June 15th, 5-6 pm.

Library Aide Report: May visitors to the library and books borrowed are as follows; 13 adults and 9 children borrowing 23 adult books and 36 children books. We received a letter from the Concord first grade class concerning their "Genius Hour Project". We're going to invite them to the library.
