Minutes of the Library Trustees Meeting

September 4, 2018

Attending: Paula Christopher, Mary Gochie, Eileen Wilson, Sharon Payeur, and Beth Cliché

Meeting was called to order at 4:07 pm by Eileen Wilson. Paula made the motion to approve the agenda, Sharon seconded. The agenda was approved. Paula made the motion to approve the minutes of August 7, meeting, Sharon seconded. The minutes were approved.

There was no public input at this time.

Library Assistants Report: Beth reported that 18 adults visited the library during the month of August, borrowing 28 books, and 6 children visited, borrowing 24 books. All new books are covered and on the shelves. We had an anonymous book request "Hey, Hey, Hay" by Christy Mihaly. It was agreed to have Beth order the new book. Beth reported that she would be out of town for training on September 20. The library trustees will cover for her absence. We suggested that Beth open her own account under Concord VT Public Library, for Facebook so she will have easier access in order to post the new books and other information as needed.

Old Business:

- 1) Book Sale Donations: We received \$13.25 in donations from the August primary election book sale.

New Business:

- 1) Paula brought in a flag stand for us to use in the library. We tried the flag that we already had, but it was too long. We will try to get a smaller flag to display in the library.
- 2) Students visit; we plan to have the preschool students visit and the second grade. Mary and Eileen visited with the new school principal, Sherri Gregory, regarding the visit. Mary will email the principal concerning how many students for each time slot, with a possible date during the last week of September. Possible time slots, 9 am – morning preschool, 10 am -2<sup>nd</sup> grade, 1pm-afternoon preschool. Beth will order book bags.
- 3) Book Purchases: We will meet later in September to purchase books to give students when they visit the library. Mary will contact everyone to set a date to go shopping.
- 4) We will do a book raffle at the Concord Historical Society Open House on September 29<sup>th</sup>. Adult book will be "Points North" by Howard Frank Moshier. Children's book will be "M is for Maple Syrup" by Cynthia Furlong Reynolds. Sharon offered to sell tickets at the open house.

Sharon made the motion to adjourn, seconded by Paula. The meeting adjourned at 5:30 pm. Our next meeting is October 2, 2018 at 4 pm at the library.
