In October we invited preschoolers and second graders of the Concord School to visit the library. We welcomed 13 second graders, with their teachers, for an introduction to the library, a story time, and snack. They checked out books and each was given a book and book bag to keep.

Also in October, 43 students from the sixth, seventh and eighth grades came for a library introduction, a story time and a snack. They checked out books and were given book bags.

In November the second graders returned for another visit to the library for story time and snack. They checked out books and were each given a gently used book to keep.

Also in November we began participating in the afterschool program at the school.

We have added many books to our collection. Most are currently published books and in addition we try to fulfill requests made by our patrons.

Lastly, we would remind people that we have free Wi-Fi available to the public as well as an in-house computer. Also, we have passes to State Historical Sites and State Parks.
