Eileen and Paula visited the School Gardens to present them with a book, a gift from our library, authored by Deborah Parrella and illustrated by Cat Bowman Smith. The title is; "Shelburne Farms, Project Seasons." The After School Program has been a success. Memorial Day Program was somewhat successful. The parade time had changed and not many people were aware of the change, the parade had to start at the Fire Station because there wasn't a permit from the state to be on Route 2. There were only two Veterans who marched in the parade, but there were 8-10 at the Park. The Veterans enjoy the candy that the library gives them each year.

New business: The Summer School Program begins July 8<sup>th</sup> this year and continues for 8 weeks.
