

Minutes of Library Trustees Meeting - Draft
Concord Public Library
July 11, 2019

Attending: Paula Christopher, Beth Cliche, Nancy LaPotin, and Eileen Wilson

Meeting was called to order by Eileen at 4:10 pm. Paula made the motion to approve the agenda, seconded by Nancy, and the agenda was approved. Nancy made the motion to approve the June 6th minutes, seconded by Paula, and the minutes were approved.

There was no public input.

Library Assistant's Report: For the month of June there were 14 adult patrons taking out 16 books, and there were 16 children taking out 6 books. There are now only 9 books still out from Mrs. Chase's group of students. The summer school kids were at the library on July 10th. The group came at 10 am. There were 16 kids in grades 1 - 7, and they took out 13 books. Nancy will fill in for Beth on Saturday July 27th.

Old Business: All books that were ordered have come in. The summer school program is underway, with 16 students and 5 adults visiting the library on July 10th. Although it was a big group, everything went smoothly and the kids took out 13 books. We will continue to have the summer school kids at the library on Wednesdays at 10 am from July 8 - August 1. Paula and Eileen will help with the summer school program on July 17th due to Beth having an appointment elsewhere. Eileen will ask Laurie how we can communicate if there is a last minute cancellation for the summer school program. Jean Sorrell has submitted her resignation and we are sorry to see her go. We will have to appoint a replacement for her. A new book request for Harlan Corbin has come in, as well as kid's requests for some dragon books. We will look into reordering Harry Potter books and Wimpy kid books due to their popularity. Fantasy books requests have also come in. Summer school staff requests are also welcome.

New Business: We want to thank Beth and Susan and Denis LaMadeleine for removing the large tenacious vine that was growing through the air conditioner. We had a discussion of library projects and performed an inventory of library promotion materials. We placed some Universe of Stories posters around the library, and will have to write a report on our activities so that we can receive additional materials in the future. A discussion about drawing more people into the library occurred and we will try to think about some new ideas.

Nancy made the motion to adjourn, seconded by Paula and Eileen adjourned the meeting at 5:40 pm. Our next meeting will be at the library on August 1 2019.
