Minutes of Library Trustees Meeting

The meeting was called to order by Eileen at 4:10 pm. Paula made the motion to approve the agenda as read, seconded by Nancy, and the agenda was approved. Nancy made the motion to approve the November 7th minutes, seconded by Paula, and the minutes were approved.

We have run out of numbers for new library patrons, and Beth will order more from Demco. We found out that all Library Trustees are purchasing agents for the library. We will continue our purchasing as we have done in the past.

Old business: Perry Lapotin has offered to repair the outside book drop box. We are thankful for his offer so we will save money as we won't be purchasing a new box.

New business: Due to the holiday season, we will be closed December 24, 26 and 31. Our vision for the New Year, 2020, is to add twenty new patrons by special invitation. Also use a punch card for how many books people take out. New book donations; we received many current western paperbacks, World War II military books, and a remarkable popup book of prehistoric beasts. Paula has written the Library Report, which will be taken to the municipal office to be entered into the 2019 Town Report.
