

Road Commissioner's Report

This past year has been busy as always for the Road Crew. Winter work requires many overtime hours with road plowing and sanding/salting. Summer work consisted of several special projects in conjunction with the usual road maintenance.

The Town completed the Road Erosion Inventory Project with the Better Roads Grant of \$8,000.00 with a 20% match which was awarded to the Town in May 2019.

The Town was awarded a Better Roads Grant in the amount of \$20,000.00, with a 20% in-kind match to continue the work on the Shadow Lake Road Project. Slope stabilization and lining the ditches with stone were done.

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic a supplemental payment of \$30,688.57 was issued to the Town by the State of Vermont in lieu of Grants being awarded.

The Town along with Heather Johnson, District Manager of the Essex County Natural Resources Conservation District and Peter Lazockok, Sr. Water Quality Specialist, from Stone Environmental are in the process of creating a Stormwater Master Plan and Design Assistance proposal for the future work to be done on Folsom Avenue and High Street.
