Road Commissioner's Report

This past year has been busy as always for the Road Crew. Winter work requires many overtime hours with road plowing and sanding/salting. Summer work consisted of several special projects in conjunction with the usual road maintenance.

The Town was awarded a Better Roads Grant in the amount of \$18,400.00, with a 20% in-kind match and a Grant In Aid in the amount of \$14,800.00, with a 20% in kind match to continue the work on the Leonard Hill Road Project. Slope stabilization and lining the ditches with stone were done.

The Town was also awarded a Paving Grant from VTrans in the amount of \$175,000.00, with a 20% match for the repaving of the Oregon Road.

The Town along with Heather Johnson, District Manager of the Essex County Natural Resources Conservation District and Peter Lazockok, Sr. Water Quality Specialist, from Stone Environmental are in the process of creating a Stormwater Master Plan and Design Assistance proposal for the future work to be done on Folsom Avenue and High Street.
