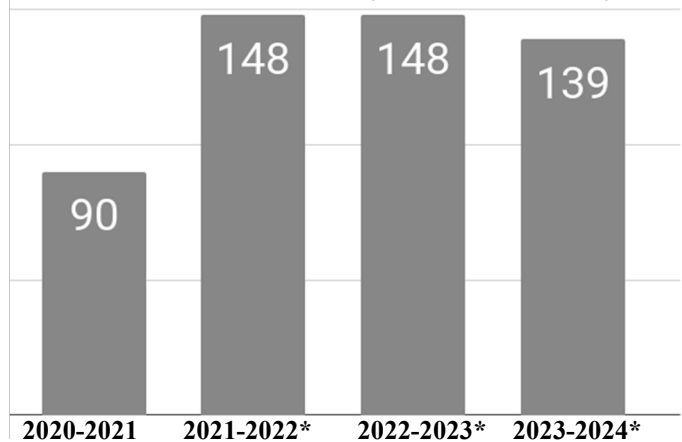
whole school events and celebrations. They have also organized 8th grade fundraisers. We appreciate our partnership with this organization.
